A

447 – the 8th planet to be infected by a mysterious plague that kills 30% of the population

Aaron – Atlantis member

Abbots of Proculus – worship Athar on the planet of Proculus, which also happens to be free from Wraith attacks.

Abrams, Dr. – one of the explorers of the LaGrangian outpost

Adams - Medic

Adaris – an Ancient science vessel

Allina – Daganian archaeologist. Rodney fell for her

Amaris – villager

Ambrose, Dr. – gives Swedish massages

Ancestral Ring – Another name for the Stargate

Ancients – old race. They explored and used the Stargate to seed the galaxy with humans. Eventually came across a sleeping race, the Wraith. They woke them and, due to arrogance, were unable to contain them. The Wraith laid siege for several years before the Ancients decided to abandon the Pegasus galaxy, putting their city to sleep and sinking it under the water to protect it. The few survivors retreated through the Stargate to Earth where they lived out their lives among the humans, presumably mating with some of them since some humans carry the Ancient gene. There may still be survivors out there somewhere.

Apparently experimented on several sentient races and may have created the Wraith. It's also possible that they created a virus that will kill humans but not Ancients. The ancients created a mechanical life form to be a weapon to fight the wraith. They were programmed with extreme rage and aggressiveness but were forbidden from harming their creators. When they did not turn out as the Ancients planned, the ancients tried to kill them all. A few bits survived and now number in the millions

Apollo – Daedalus class ship, commanded by colonel Abe Ellis

Ara - a friend of Ronon. They were lost and presumed dead. Ronon befriended them and was going to join them until it was revealed that they had become Wraith Worshipers. Ara and Rakai were killed, Tyre escaped.

archetype – Poole's project

Arclight – radio ID Sheppard called

ARG – Anti Replicator Gun – Created by Carter to combat the Replicators

Aries – second in command of the child planet, M7G677

Arlesia – advanced planet that confined its prisoners to an island. The island also contained the gate so the Wraith fed off the prisoners. However, when they did not have enough prisoners to satiate the Wraith, charges were trumped up and minor offenders were also sent there, and potentially also dissenters

Arlesia Island – Arlesia's prison

Ascendometer – measures how close one is to ascension

Asgard Plasma Beam Weapon – asgard technology that is very effective on Replicator ships. The Daedalus and Apollo possess it

Astrp – monk on Dagan

Asuran Nanites – nanites that made Weir hallucinate

Asuras – city that is the image of Atlantis but was created by the surviving replicators. They now number in the millions

ATA – Ancient Technology Activation, caused by a single gene instructing cells to produce a series of proteins and enzymes. It occurs naturally in some folks, can be artificially induced in others.

Athar – goddess who the Proculeans believe protect them. She is really Chaya, an Ancient who has been cast out and sentenced to guard the planet for all eternity

Atlantis – fabled city of the Ancients, located in the Pegasus Galaxy. Their DHD is the only one with a control crystal. The city possessed 6 grounding towers which protect it from lightening. Protected by 4

Atlantis crew to get him more

Attero Device - it disrupts subspace, keeping the wraith from using their hyperdrive but has the side effect of blowing up every stargate that is used

Aurora – Ancient warship. The Captain was carrying Intel on a weakness of the Wraith. The ship was attacked and the crew put into stasis. It was found by the Atlantis people and eventually destroyed to keep the Wraith from getting their hands on it.

Ava Dixon – replicator made by Dr Richard Poole. She helped to apprehend an escaped replicator and is now 'living' in a virtual reality

Avrid – one of the people in the sanctuary hoping to attain Ascension. Teer's brother

B

Baden – Leader of Hallona

Balar - the planet was attacked by Michael and infected with the Hoffman drug. The survivors ran but are being hunted by the Wraith

Baldric – member of the village. Assisted Rodney in exploring the catacombs under the city

Balera – her necklace was found by Teyla. She'd been given it as a coming of age gift

Bambus – member of Sheppard's new team after he returned to earth

Banks, Amelia - 5 years of kickboxing gateroom tech

Barroso, Sgt. - injured by Maj. Leonard's booby-trap, he died of his injuries

Bates, Sgt. – Security officer on Atlantis. He was critically injured when the Wraith attacked the city. is now working for the IOA in a new field division dealing with operational threats on Earth

Baxter, Gerald, Dr – member of Katie Brown's group. He has a bug collection. He fell ill with Kirsan Fever and died

Beckett, Carson, Dr – Medical doctor. Scottish. Close to his mother. He's been working on a retrovirus to mask the Iratus DNA and allow the human DNA in the Wraith come forth. He's from a family of seven. He was killed when a scientist who had been exposed to an Ancient device, developed an explosive tumor which detonated. His childhood hero was Dougie Angus Wood. A clone of him was found among captives of Michael's and brought back to Atlantis. They were unable to stop the cellular degradation so he was placed in a stasis pod , They figured out how to stop the degradation and now Beckett lives **in and amongst the people of the Pegasus Galaxy. Michael gave him the Hoffman drug, so he is now inedible.**

Belkan a planet that Atlantis trades with Teyla visits there to trade for some flax seed

Bell, Sgt – died of an aneurysm

Bingham, April – Rod's first crush

Biro, Dr. – did autopsies on victims of the virus member of the Atlantis expedition

Bob – Genii

Bola Kai – race/tribe of vicious warriors. They like to 'pick fights' and are cannibalistic

Bolton – Flew a puddle jumper to try and clear an asteroid belt to give the city safe passage

Branton, Mike – member of the expedition who likes Elizabeth.

Brotherhood of the Fifteen – group of monks assigned to keep the ZPM safe on Dagan. Comprised of a master handler, 5 protectors, 9 stone carriers

Brown, Katie, Dr – botanist on Atlantis. Had a date with Rodney. Never gets to

go off world. She is studying ferns from M4L279 which may have the cure for leukemia. She fell ill with Kirsan Fever and nearly died. She named one of the plants they found on the new mainland after Rodney
Bryce, Dr. – studying the Ancient data base

C

Cadman, Laura, Lt – came to Atlantis on the Daedalus. Was briefly melded with Rodney during an accident. Nearly died without getting back into her own body. Likes to run and sleep in the nude. Also fancies Carson. Tap dances and is a demolitions expert. She and Carson didn't work out.

Caldwell, Steve, Col. – Commander of Daedalus. Was supposed to be military commander of the city but, at Weir's request, Sheppard got the command instead. He was blended with one of the Trust's symbiotes and tried to sabotage Atlantis. He was discovered and Hermoid beamed the symbiote out of him

Carter, Samantha, Dr., Col., USAF- worked on deciphering the gate but did not go to Abydos. Continued working on the puzzle during the year it was inactive then was reassigned to the SGC when the gate was reactivated. Doctor of Astrophysics. Always had a childhood dream of becoming an astronaut. Has a brother, Mark, she rarely sees. Her father, General Jacob Carter was blended with the Tok'ra Selmac and lives off world. Was accidentally blended with the Tok'ra Jolinar of Malkshur who was killed by an Ashrak nearly killing her. Retains memories of Jolinar's and is able to control some Goa'uld devices. Mother died when she was in her teens in a cab accident. Blamed her father for a time since he was supposed to pick her up but was late. Her forgiveness of her father led her to join the military. Since she possesses the memories of at least two beings she is hesitant to get into a relationship until she is sure whose feelings she is feeling. Has an Uncle Irving who apparently is quite a character. Can pick locks. Graduated from the Air Force Academy. Most of her records still stand. Some think that her surviving Jolinar's possession means that her body holds the key to un-go'ulding people. Three 'hobbies', wormhole theory, motorcycle riding, lock picking. Mother used to sing twinkle, twinkle, little star to her. Recently promoted to Lieutenant Colonel. and is engaged to Pete Shanahan. she drives a silver Volvo four-door sedan, license plate: Colorado QTL3016. Is now assigned to area 51, research and development and has chosen to return to the SGC to assist in stopping the Priors/Orii.. She's 'not exactly' single. Did time on the Prometheus after leaving the SGC and has now returned to the SGC to help fight the Ori. Her quarters are right down the hall from her lab. She was seriously injured attempting a field trial on a Cloaking

Camouflage device on P9C882 and was also sent to an alternate universe. Two time recipient of the Binder Prize for Advancements in Theoretical Physics. Has been promoted to full colonel and is the commanding officer of Atlantis

Casta - one of the children sent to keep an eye on McKay and Ford on M7G677

Celise - her family was slaughtered by the wraith because they gave shelter to Kiryk

Cetus – Lantean Replicator Asurian

Charin – Ethosian Elder and confidant of Teyla's. She died of old age and they performed the Ring Ceremony, designed to celebrate those few Ethosians that die of natural causes

Chaya – High priestess of Athar. Is really Athar herself, who is an ascended Ancient. She broke their rules by defending the people of Proculus and is sentenced to protect them for all eternity, then and no others. Visits Atlantis where her identity is found out. She befriends Sheppard but returns to her home.

Chief Kalan – Genii

Chieftan – the name given to the leader of Sateda

Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin – Keller's home town. Her father lives there, her mother is deceased

Chuck – control room tech, Canadian

Cleo – one of the children sent to keep an eye on McKay and Ford on M7G677

Cole, Dr. – under Beckett's command. He relieved her when she had a migraine

Cole, Sgt. – Security officer in Michael's detail

Coleman – scientist. She stayed on the drilling platform

Coleman, Dr. – observed McKay while he had his super powers

Collins – assisted in trying to figure out the weapon Rodney found. He was killed in an accident

Conrad, Vanessa, Dr - persona the Sakari AI took to communicate with Woolsey

Coolidge, Mr. - New member of the IOA. Conducted interviews of all the aliens involved in the projects.

Corrigan, Dr. – anthropologist

Cowan – Genii leader. He was killed by Radim's coup.

Crown, Lt. – infected with the virus

Croya, village of – located on M2S181. Teyla bought a necklace there that she gave to Kanaan as a gift. She returned there searching for him

CSIS – Canadian Security Intelligence Services, the Canadian equivalent of the CIA. Assisted in Jeanie's kidnapping

D

Dagan – planet, one of the five outposts found by the Old Weir home of the Sudarian priests.

Davos – known as a Seer

Deera – Villager on M1K177. She helped Ronon and Teyla find out what happened to Lorne

Dempster – Midway crewman that was killed when the Wraith invaded

Dex – old buddy of Sheppard's. Killed on a mission

Dex, Ronan, Specialist – his people were attacked by the Wraith. For some reason, they could not feed from him so they implanted him with a tracking device and have spent the past 7 years hunting him. In exchange for Carson removing the device, Ronan has pledged his assistance in finding Ford. He has a fanatical hatred of the Wraith. His childhood hero was Marke Hartoren and he tries not to worry about stuff he can't change. He's had a run-in with the Travelers at some point in time since he uses one of their weapons

Dickinson – killed by wraith queen in the drilling platform

Dimas of the Free Peoples of Riva - member of the council that judged Atlantis. His planet is seeking a coalition with the Genii

DMT – Devlin Medical Technologies – Company owned by Henry Wallace. It did work with nanites

Donaldson – scientist

Donovan, Lt - team was on a diplomatic mission to M2J along with Zelenka

Doran – Ethosian, tricked into betraying Atlantis

Dorandan – wonderful people mentioned in Atlantis' database 10,000 years ago. They created a weapon to capture energy from our subspace and tried to use it against the Wraith in a last ditch attempt. They failed and the subsequent energy burst killed every living thing on their planet. The planet was a weapons research facility of the Ancients.

Dorsey, Major – Atlantis team member

Drakes – Marine that survived the Wraith attack

Drone – Ancient protective device. It operates like a missile, usually following the commands of those controlling the Ancient devices. Kinda looks like a squid

Druhin – Hoffman chancellor

Dumais – killed by virus

E

Edison - Watching the entrance as Shep and his team searched for Teyla. He brought word back to Atlantis that the team had been injured

Edison – Team leader

Eldon – prisoner. Convicted, wrongly he says, of killing a person. Made the explosives that shot down the puddle jumper

Eldred – Village elder

Ellia – Wraith child found by Zaddik. She tried to act human but after taking the retrovirus, lost all her human characteristics and became fully Wraith.

Ellis, Abe, Col – Commander of the Apollo

Elson - leader of the Village

Emmagan, Torren John - Teyla's son

Enchuri Plant – the sap of this plant treats Kirsan Fever

Ennea – One of the children on M7G677

Erik – Daganian

Erran - mother of a child Keller treated. she will adopt Celise

Esposito, Dr. – she thinks Ronon is hot

Athos – home of the Athosians. It fell to the Wraith and the survivors are now living on the mainland of Atlantis

Everett, Dillon, Col – USMC – sent to Atlantis to reinforce their troops and try to hold the city under siege. Was a friend to Marshall Sumner and has issues with Sheppard for killing Sumner

F

Ferrell – one of Everett's Marines, KIA

Flagecallus – a telepathic whale like creature that lives in Atlantis' oceans.

Fletcher, Adam, Dr. – Weir's psychologist

Flora – Harmony's older sister

Ford, Aiden, Lt – second in command of the military stuff. Very enthusiastic. No parents, raised by his grandparents. Was attacked by the Wraith and nearly killed. Is now under the influence of a Wraith enzyme that boosts his strength and metabolism, but also his paranoia

Fortnum– Genii. Member of Cowan's personal guard that fled Genii when Ladin Radim took power. Lucis broke his wrist. They helped Lucius keep his persona as a hero by being vigilantes.

FRAN- Friendly Replicator Android. Created by Rodney to be the 'trojan horse' to destroy the replicators

Fuller – SGC guard

G

Garrett, Dr. - Ronon surprised him. Ronon stunned the man when he surprised Ronon at a party

Gaul, Brendan, Dr – scientist who explores the planet where a Wraith ship has crashed. Is attacked by the Wraith and aged. Eventually kills himself to allow Rodney to go help Sheppard

Geldar – the name of McKay's country

Geldar, Teresa – Rod dated her in high school and he named a country after her.

Genii- people pretending to be simple farmers. Are really rather warlike. They possess and use nuclear weapons. And are also capable of manufacturing quite an elaborate plot. There's recently been a coup and only time will tell if the new bosses are any better than those they overthrew

Geothermal drilling platform – abandoned Ancient project

Gerrel Mylan – found the protein that led to the development of the Wraith poison

Gift of Life – the wraith can take life force from one person and give it to another. It is something usually reserved for their brothers and devout followers

Goron – one of the villagers where a marooned Wraith was killing his people. His son, Zaddik was believed dead, but had really left the village to care for a survivor of the attack, a young Wraith child

Grant – Nancy's husband, attorney.

Graydon, Dr – he's been at Atlantis 8 months. McKay meant to ask for Greyson instead. He was killed by the wraith queen in the drilling platform

Griffin – the pilot of jumper 6. He dies when he and Rodney crash into the sea

Grodin, Peter – doctor, apparently head researcher of Atlantis tech. He was killed when the Wraith attacked Atlantis

grounding stations. Is really a space craft that's settled in a planet. It is 18 days in hyperspace from Earth to Atlantis. Now that Atlantis has a working ZPM, they can gate to Earth, but not gate back.

H

Haemon – Genii. Member of Cowan's personal guard that fled Genii when Ladin Radim took power. They helped Lucius keep his persona as a hero by being vigilantes.

Halling – one of the Ethosians. Jinto's dad. His ring was found by Teyla amongst stuff taken by Michael. He was found by and rescued by the Atlantis team.

Hallona – Sheppard's country

Harmony – young girl Sheppard and McKay helped to be Queen

Harris - combat engineer. he was on leave during Michael's attack

Hays – killed by virus

Hedda – one of the Cloistered ones. She's a child but also is a healer

Heightmeyer, Kate, Dr. – psychologist assigned to Atlantis

Heiron – one of the Genii that tried to kill Harmony

Helia , Captain – commander of the Tria, an Lantean warship that the Daedalus found traveling between the two galaxies. She is now in residence at Atlantis and has requested that the humans leave

Helkin – a Geldarian scientist

Hemi - friend of Ronon's. They were killed when they refused to become Wraith Worshipers

Hendon – Trader on Belkan

Herick – pilot of the Ark. He lost his wife and son when the Wraith attacked

Hermoid – Asgard serving on Daedalus. Is not quite fond of his posting. His human liaison is Lindsay Novak.

Hester – Atlantis Marine that was killed on Midway

Hipapheralkus – original name of the ship found on Taranis. It was named after an Ancient general. Sheppard renamed it Orion

Hoff – planet that has been attacked by the Wraith for generations. They have preserved all their knowledge from each attack and have been working on an anti-Wraith serum. It has its base in a unique protein that made one Hoffman immune to attack. Beckett works with them and perfects a serum, however it has a 50% mortality rate among the humans it's given to, and it turns into a poison in the Wraith's blood, thus killing any Wraith that dares to attack anyone who's been inoculated.

Holland, Lyle, Capt – old comrade of Sheppard's. his chopper was shot down in Afghanistan and Sheppard disobeyed orders to go back and get him. Holland did not survive

Horizon – weapons platform. It contains 6 mark 9 tactical nukes and 4 decoys

Houston, Dr. – was exploring a lab in Atlantis. She was exposed to an ancient device that led to the formation of explosive tumors. Hers exploded, killing 3 and injuring 12.

I

Iratus bug – bug that, somehow, overwrote human DNA and created the Wraith. The Wraith are a hybrid, half human, half bug. The bugs nest in caves

and are very protective of their eggs

J

Jace – One of Aiden's Lost Boys. Was killed on the Wraith ship

Jamus – Lead scientist in the Ark project

Janus – Ancient scientist who created the time ship. He also allowed the old Weir to remain behind to 'save' Atlantis in the future. Evacuated to Earth, **had a secret lab in the city 'bastion of unfettered thoughts and experimentation', Isle of solitude within the city walls**

Jenev – a closed society. Lorne took his team on a mission there

Jervis - **wants to turn the Balerans over to the Wraith. He is killed in a trap to stop the Wraith**

Jinto – Ethosian boy, Halling's son

Johnson – killed by virus

Jordan, Major –On a mission on M34227 where he was contacted by RepliWeir

K

Kagan, Lt. – injured by Maj. Leonard's booby-trap. He survived

Kanaan – the father of Teyla's child. He also has the Wraith gene. Teyla's friend. He's a natural born leader, yet also very cautious. He and she have a growing relationship. He is among the missing of New Athos

Kanayo –once a Genii spy, one of Aiden's Lost Boys, dies of withdrawal while they are captives of the

Katana Labrea - **Traveler. she survived when their first colony in generations was destroyed when the Attero device blew up its stargate**

Kaufman – assigned to Atlantis

Kavanaugh, Peter – scientist. He has a grudge against Weir and sent messages to Earth, noting all her failures. Returned to Earth, asked to come back then changed his mind. He was suspected of attempting sabotage. He is/was assigned to Midway and suggested that he didn't ask for the job as much as it was given to him

Kell – mentor of Ronan's, he settled on Belsa and runs a trading depot. He was Ronan's 'task master'...mentor and trainer. He used his own men to cover his escape during the Wraith attack. Ronan kills him...and none of his men seem to mind

Keller, Jennifer Dr. – acting head of medical. She temporarily replaced Beckett when he was killed. She's overwhelmed by the job. She's from Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin where her father still lives, her mother is deceased. She can't cook and isn't athletic.

Kelore of Latira - member of the council that judged Atlantis

Kemp, Lt. – Part of Lorne's squad as he searched the city- Most likely killed on M9R373 along with his team when the replicators attacked

Kenmore, Michael, Lt. – identity given to a Wraith that was captured and then treated with Carson's retrovirus. He reverted to human form, but soon discovered his true origins and returned to the Wraith, carrying with him full knowledge of Atlantis' survival. He's known in Carson's logs as Patient 4364. He has not reverted totally back to being a wraith, but is wraith in temperament only. The wraith hate the human in him, the humans hate the wraith in him and he is hunted by both sides. He is currently trying to genetically engineer an army of hybrids. He has apparently had some success and is to blame for the spread of the Hoffman plague. He 'has great plans' for Teyla's child. He is killed after invading Atlantis and threatening Teyla's child.

Kenny - Primary's second in command, killed by Todd

Keras – Elder on child run planet

Keturah – Lenor's father and village leader. He turned Ronon into the Wraith, but then was killed in the subsequent attack

Kirsan Fever – a common childhood ailment in the Pegasus galaxy but that has, on one planet anyway, mutated into a memory eating bacteria that is fatal if left untreated

Kiryk - a Runner. he possesses a small teleporter

Kleinman, Dave, Capt – Weapons officer on Daedalus

Kolya, Acastus, Cmdr – leader of the Genii people. Has been missing for months. But this may or may not be true. He successfully kidnapped Sheppard and tortured him, trying to get Atlantis to hand over Ladon Radim. Sheppard escaped, and so did Kolya. Kolya was killed by Sheppard after he attacked a planet Lucius Luvlin was hiding on.

Koracen - an Alteran that wants to find a technical way to ascend

Kusanagi, Dr. – has ATA gene

L

La Grangian Satellite - was discovered by Dr. Gall and was part of the defense systems of Atlantis

Lanko – Genii. Member of Cowan's personal guard that fled Genii when Ladin

Radim took power. Lucius broke three of his teeth. They helped Lucius keep his persona as a hero by being vigilantes.

Lantian – another name for the Ancients...Atlantians

Lara – Aiden's cousin. Knows that he's missing but his grandparents don't

Largent – Member of Leonard's team

Larrin – Associate of Silas and Nevik. One of the Travelers, people who live their whole lives on board ships, only stopping at planets to get food. They kidnapped Sheppard to use his Ancient Gene to try and reactivate an abandoned Ancient warship.

Lathan – name given to a transformed Wraith. He was killed by his own

Lenor – a woman that tried to help Ronon. She was fed on by the Wraith

Leonard, Maj – his team was exploring M1B129 and ran across an old wraith device. It seems to induce extreme paranoia and hallucinations. Leonard killed all of his team and other members with Sheppard's team

Levels - 35 - 128 are connected in one stairwell. then at level 63 you take another ancillary stairwell up four levels to the gateroom

Levine - Flew a puddle jumper to try and clear an asteroid belt to give the city safe passage

Lia - one of Weir's Alteran friends

Linara – Davos' daughter

Lindsay, Dr. – Member of Atlantis, she was with Lorne's team, teaching the people of M1K177 about more efficient farming and fishing methods

Lindstrom, Dr. – Killed by Wraith virus

Lord Protector – leader of a planet. Who is leader is determined by who can control the Ancients stuff left behind in the city

Lorne, Major – assigned to Atlantis and is a team leader. He possesses the Ancient Gene. His mother was an art teacher. He's a pilot. He has two nephews, 5 and 7 and a sister. He spent time in/grew up in the Bay area and used to frequent an open air market there.

Lost Treasure of Quindozium – ZPM

Luvn, Lucius – a baker that discovered a plant that made him irresistible. He used it to get himself six wives and to be popular. He used it upon the Atlantis crew but they figured it out and made an antidote. He was returned home. He fled his home planet and sought refuge on another one where he used the Ancient personal shield to create the persona of a hero.

Lycus, Chancellor – leader of Taranis

M

M12-578 – chosen to be the new home of Atlantis when it fled the Replicator attack. It has a inhabital atmosphere and large ocean Due to a malfunction, it never arrived

M1B129 – Moon that had a wraith device on it that made members of Leonard's team and later Sheppard's team go nuts and try to kill each other

M1K177 – Planet were Lorne's team was thought lost

M1R992 – another plague infected planet

M2R441 – delivered medical supplies. It's misty, with ancient ruins. 'Todd' made contact with Atlantis there

M2S181 – village of Croya. There's a market there

M2S445 - Michaels' ship was in orbit of this planet when it was destroyed

M33985 - Keller is there for a medical follow up when she is kidnapped

M34227 – planet where Major Jordan was on a mission and where he was contacted by Repliweir

M35117 – Atlantis' new home. The planet has a large ocean and a mainland inhabited by large, venomous snake like creatures

M3R428 – unused gate 'harvested' for the link between Pegasus Galaxy and the Milky Way

M3X387 – Planet of the glowing crystals. They entice you to touch them, then the entity spreads via touch, inducing nightmares

M445YN - the gate flooded when an ice dam broke, stranding Sheppard's team and killing Dr Nichols' team

M4D058 – planet where Sheppard and McKay thought they were playing a game. In reality they were dealing with two real groups of people

M4F788 – one of the planets in the series of gates used to 'fast forward' people to Midway Station. It was discovered by the Wraith – Todd stole its location and codes when he was on Atlantis and they hacked into the system and used it to launch an invasion of the SGC

M4L279 – where Atlantis found some ferns that might have the cure for leukemia. Katie Brown is studying them.

M4S587 – Meeting place with Ladon to get intel on Teyla. As Sheppard gated home a solar flare sent him 48,000 years into the future where he learned that Teyla dies in two months, Carter in about four, Ronon and Todd soon thereafter. Woolsey gets command of Atlantis and scales back all humanitarian efforts. Rodney quits, marries Keller who dies in less than a year. Rodney set himself up as a hologram to go to the future to help Sheppard get back home with the intel to hopefully change the dark future.

M4X337 – barren planet where energy sucking entity was sent to

M5S224 – planet with sentient mist

M5S768 – visited last year, destroyed by the Replicators

M5V801 – a planet that the Genii invaded about 20 years ago. They enslaved the people and forced them to work in mines. Once the mines were finished, the Genii left, but the people are living on seismically unstable land and suffer from at least four tremors a day. Atlantis attempted to negotiate with them to find them a new home, but the mission ran into trouble when Keller, Carter and McKay fell into an abandoned mine.

M6H491- planet where Lucius got his irresistible plant. It fell under Wraith control and he convinced

M6H987 - Ice/blizzard planet where the aliens took mckay and Daniel when they kidnapped them

M6R125 – planet on the edge of the Pegasus Galaxy that was used to replace **M4F788**

M6R214 – site of some Wraith destroying a couple of Replicator ships

M6R867 – Ladon's hideout

M72656 – Lorne's team was under attack there and Rodney rescued them

M7G-677 – One of the 5 outposts noted by Old Weir, other wise known as the planet of the Kids, since most of its inhabitants are less than 25 years old Later their shield acted up and McKay went to fix it

M7R227 - Replicator home world. It was destroyed and the replicators trapped within it

M8G352 – Where the team experimented on re-humanizing a group of wraith. They figured it out and rebelled. It was Michael's 'birthplace' and where he captured Carson's DNA to make a clone of him

M8R1229 – the ocean on this planet is under a thick sheet of ice

M9R373 – Planet Lt Kemp was evacuating. The replicators struck sooner than expected and all are presumed dead

Maastricht University – Radek had an offer of a job there

Magistrate – leader on Arlesia

Malcolm – died in Wraith attack

Mallozzi, Dr. – has a huge anime collection

Manara – have a trade agreement with Atlantis. Gave them refuge during the storm but also told the Genii

Mara – Daughter of the Lord Protector

Marco – pilot

Mardola – Harmony's older sister. She partnered with the Genii and tried to get Harmony killed so that she could be queen

Marie – head nurse on Atlantis

Marika – friend of Ronon's. They were killed when they refused to become Wraith Worshipers

Marin – female on Arlesia. Tried to warn the Atlanteans and was arrested

Mark 9 – Gate buster nuke

Markham, Sgt – piloting puddle jumper while Sheppard was attacked by the bug

Marks - Kevin

Marta – Ethosian

Massan, Cassel – Ladon's personal assistant

Mattas – trader on Belkan

Matthews – KIA trying to shut off the power drain after Atlantis fled the Replicator attack

McKay-Carter Intergalactic Gate Bridge – a series of 34 gates that can be used to link the Pegasus and Milky Way galaxy, cutting the trip time from 3 weeks to just 30 minutes

McKay, Rodney (Meredith), Dr – expert in Stargate tech, working to interface Ancient tech to human tech lost his dog as a kid. His sister is Jeannie. By his own admission he's self absorbed and bad with people. He understands Ancient tech but is also quite...difficult to work with. He also has a food obsession. His real first name is Meredith. He hasn't talked to his sister in four years ever since she decided to get married and have a baby. He and Carter created a Gate Bridge to link the Pegasus and Milky Way galaxies. His childhood hero was Batman He can't stand surprises and used to open his Christmas presents. He tried to propose to Katie Brown but realized that he was too negative, demanding and arrogant to make it work at that point in time. His computer password is 16431879196842. 1643, birth year of Newton, 1879, birthyear of Einstein, 1968, Rodney's birth year and 42

McNab, Dr. – studying the ocean on M8R1229.

Mehra, Dusty, SGT - SGA team member

Melena – Ronon's wife. She was killed in the attack up on Sateda

Merell – terminal ill Hoffman that volunteered for testing of the serum

Merrik – Humanized Wraith

Michael - he's 'bombing' planets with the Hoffman drug, killing half the population, rendering the other half inedible. The other Wraith are now massacring the survivors. AKA Michael Kenmore

Midway Space Station – the transition point of the Gate Bridge where the two galaxies meet. It is still under construction. It was completed and in use for about a year before its location was discovered by the Wraith and it was destroyed.

Miko – scientist who has a bit of a crush on Rodney

Mila - Katana's chief engineer. she's 15 but has been working on engines since she was 4

Miller, Jeanie – Rodney's sister. She's a theoretical physicist but is now a stay

at home mom. She used to be afraid of the dark. She was kidnapped and infected by nanites by Henry Wallace in an attempt to cure his daughter. Jeanie survived, Sharon Wallace did not

Miller, Kaleb – Rodney's brother in law, Jeanie's wife

Miller, Lt. – scanned Ladon's planet

Miller, Madison – Jeanie and Kaleb's daughter, Rodney's neice

Mini Drones – tiny, personal sized drones

Mirellus - trapped on planet with Michael's experiments, killed by them

Mitch -old buddy of Sheppard's. Killed on a mission

Monroe, Dr – Killed by Wraith virus

Moore, Dr. – studying the ocean on M8R1229

Morrison, Lt – he was on guard detail on the planet and was killed by the human Wraith. He found Lathan's body

Myers – Atlantis personnel, works in medical

Myrus - representative of the New Coalition of Planets. Brought word to Atlantis that the city was on trial

N

Nabel Folan – man who said he was Genii when found on New Athos, but he may have been lying. He could be a wraith worshipper and might know the location of Teyla's missing people. He fell into working with Michael and was injured trying to ambush the team. He was promised safety for telling them the location of Michael's labs.

Nancy – Shep's ex. She's a director at Homeland Security.

Nanite Medical Program – project of Rodney's to use Replicator nanites to fix humans

Neaves, Dr – another medical doctor on Atlantis

Neera – woman on hive ship. She's one of many who sees the Wraith as allies and works with them

Negley, Lt. – Marine. Killed by Michael

Neleus – One of the children

Nelson, Major - his team was overpowered by Michael so that he could get a puddle jumper to invade the city

Nevik – Larrin's chief science officer. He was killed when the Ancient ship they were trying to acquire was attacked by the Wraith

New Athos – new 'home world' of the Athosians. They vanished without a trace

Niam – human form replicators that sought a more spiritual existence. He helped the Atlantis crew escape. He later turned on them and was killed in the

attempt to retake the city. He was last seen floating in space. The Atlantis team attempted to use him to retake the city after it was conquered by Asurans. He died in the attempt.

Nichols, Dr - Atlantis personnel, Killed when ice dam broke on M445YN

Nola – Leader of the Geldar

Nolar Lumsbrik – one of the greatest hunters. He taught Harmony for three sessions

Novak, Lindsay, Dr. – works in engineering on Daedalus. Is the human 'keeper' for Hermoid, the Daedalus' Asgard assistant. Hiccups when she's nervous

Novo - she's assisting Beckett. She's a Baleran refugee

O

Oberoth – leader of the Asurans. (human form replicators). He was killed when Niam rebelled however, like all Asurans, he can be regenerated

Omal – leader of the Bola Kai on New Athos

Optican - Scientist

Oracle, the – the leader given to the mysterious source of information for the people of M4D058 and other planets

Orin – person Teyla knows. close friend of Teyla's father

Orion – new name of the Hipapheralkus

Otho – Lord Chamberlain, is rather skilled in poisons and is charged with maintaining the family tree to insure proper genetics of the Lord Protector's family. He dies when an attempted coup fails

P

P3M 736 – planet with a high UV rating. Ford hid there for a bit and it is where the Atlanteans come across Ronan Dex

P4M399 – a tiny planet on the outskirts of our galaxy

P7G-677 – one of the 5 outposts noted by Old Weir

Parker - Left on gate duty while Sumner's team made contact with Teyla's people

Parrish, Dr - botanist assigned to Atlantis

Peel, Graham, Prof – a profession at the California Institute of Technology where Jeanie sent her math proof

Pegasus Galaxy – where Atlantis is

Pelius – one of the children

Pendant of Wairos – piece of Ancient tech that controls the mini drones and is passed from queen to queen

Perna – Chief scientists on the project to find the Wraith inoculation

Pero, Norina, Dr. – scientist on Taranis. She was running the geo-thermal powered shield system and inadvertently started a chain reaction that resulted in awakening the super volcano

Peterson – killed by virus

Petra – Eldred's wife(?)

PFD- Ancient scanning device

Phoenix – human-Asgard ship that Colonel Carter is given command of in the alternative timeline

Pilatian Solar Cells – Aiden's group stole those too but can't get them working

Plague – a new disease that's been randomly spread. It's a 'new and improved' version of the Hoffman disease. The only improvement is that the death toll is 30% instead of 50%. those that survive are immune from feeding.

Poros – Arlesians security vessel

Porter, Alison, Dr - SGA team member

Potentia – What the Daganians call the ZPM

Prenum – Genii with whom Elizabeth negotiated to get a nuke

Primary - head queen wraith

Proculus – planet that is apparently immune to Wraith attack and has no knowledge of them. It is protected by the goddess Athar, who is really Chaya, an Ancient who's been cast out.

Project Arcturus – trying to make a power supply that is better than ZPM's

Prophecy of the Great Awakening – a prophecy in which it's said that when the Wraith awaken, Armageddon is coming. Because of this, humans are starting to worship the Wraith

Puddle Jumper – Ancient ship that is small enough to fly through a Stargate

PWARW – planetary wide anti replicators weapon

Q

Quindosim – group of 15 monks charged with protecting the Potentia, aka a ZPM

R

Radim, Dahlia – Ladon's sister. She was suffering from radiation poisoning and

was exchanged to Atlantis as a hostage. Carson has begun to treat her and the others hoping to cure as many as possible.

Radim, Ladon – Genii. Contacted Atlantis and said he was leading a coup. His coup was a success but only time will tell if his leadership was better than Cowan's or not. He helped Atlantis recover Sheppard when he was captured by Kolya. He was Cowan's chief scientist

Radner, Capt– one of Everett's men

Rakai - a friend of Ronon. They were lost and presumed dead. Ronon befriended them and was going to join them until it was revealed that they had become Wraith Worshipers. Ara and Rakai were killed, Tyre escaped.

Reading Library – part of the city that is rarely used

Rebel Replicators – an offshoot of the regular replicators. They seek ascension and want to explore humans

Reed – assigned to Atlantis

Reed Richards – the pseudo Sheppard used when he was interrogated by the Travelers

Renni - council member. she took in Novo

Replicators – beings created by the Ancients with a program of Organic assimilation and self-replication. The Ancients attempted to destroy them, they survived and thrived. They created the anti-human virus as an attempt to fight against the Ancients. There are rebels within the replicators, some that wish to study the humans while others wish to kill all the humans in an effort to defeat the Wraith by eliminating their food supply. For a period of time they could take any form they wished. They are presumed dead, imprisoned within the center of their own planet.

Richard Poole, Dr. - worked at Stanton research. He made Ava and was killed by an escaped replicator

Ring Ceremony – an Ethosian ritual that celebrates those lucky few that die of natural causes

Rivers - Marine assigned to Atlantis. Ordered by Carter to take jumper into orbit to look for attack

Robbins, Captain – delivering medical supplies to M2R441. The planet was recently culled. 'Todd' made contact through Robbins

Rodneyana Villosa – plant Katie named after Rodney. Its spines can pierce skin

Roundhouse 06 – Sheppard's radio id during his rescue effort

Runner – name for people that the Wraith hunt for sport/training/play

Rutger, Joccelyn – Rodney took her to see Alien and threw up on her

Ruus Wine – it has a sweet taste but packs a surprising kick. Athosian beverage

S

Sakari - race that saw its own death coming so 'seeded' fifty worlds with pods, all of which never responded. The pod on the new Atlantis planet was activated by activity on the planet and the Sakiri AI made its presence known to enlist the assistance of the SGA personnel to help it get to a new world

Sam – McKay's name for Flagecallus, a whale like fish that lives in the oceans.

Sateda – Ronan's home planet

Second Childhood - a phenomenon caused by radiation on Talus that causes a parasite to shrink

Section Seven – Infirmary

Sereef Sua - Tyre almost tied on a run there. Ronon risked his life to save Tyre

Sheppard, Dave – John's brother. He stayed with the family business while John shunned it. The two brothers are estranged.

Sheppard, John, Lt Colonel – now the ranking military officer on Atlantis, likes football, size matters to him. Piloted an osprey, black hawk, apache, cobra, had never set foot on Antarctica. Has a blackmark on his record about some arms deal. Promoted to Lt. Colonel and is now officially the military commander of Atlantis. His childhood hero was Evil Knievel. He has been married before. He's afraid of clowns. His family is rather well off, however John is estranged from them.

Sheppard, Patrick – John's father. He was a utilities mogul and quite well off. Him and John had some disagreements and Shep pulled out of his father's life. Patrick died at 69

Sherman – assigned to Atlantis

Shiana of the Tribes of Santhal - member of the council that judged Atlantis. All her family was killed by the Rogue Replicators

Shrine of Talus - where to take people suffering from the parasitic infection for one last day of awareness before they die

Sifaris - villager

Silas – Associate of Larrin. He was killed when the Ancient ship they were trying to acquire was attacked by the Wraith

Simpson -Atlantis scientist who worked on saving the puddle jumper when they got stuck in the gate

Smeadon – Leader of the Manarians. Sheppard asks them for sanctuary to evacuate Atlantis for the storm. Smeadon turns them over to the Genii

Smith – died in Wraith attack

Smitty -Sumner put him on gate duty when the rest of the team visited Teyla's people

Sobol, Colonel - one of the AU commanders of the Daedalus

Solan Sineha - survived wraith attack on Sateda, they encountered him on a trade mission to Belkan

Solen Sensor – served in the same regiment as Ronan

Sora – Genii, Tyrus' daughter. Wishes to avenge his death. She was left behind when the Genii tried to capture Atlantis and is now a captive/prisoner. Hates Teyla

Stackhouse, Sgt – in front of puddle jumper while Sheppard was attacked by the bug

Stanton Research – a division of Devlin Medical Technologies. It made a replicator and Ava Dixon

Steve – Sheppard's name for the Wraith captive

Sudarian People – the name for the Daganians pre-Culling

Sudarian Priests – priests on Dagan

Sumner, Marshall, Col – leader of the military contingent of the Atlantis explorers, killed by a Wraith. USMC

Suneera – Daganian woman, sympathetic to Genii

T

Taffa – treat, food, on M5V801.

Taken – term referring to Ethosians who were taken by the Wraith, then returned. Many of them went mad, murdered and killed. The survivors were exiled. They were likely the survivors of the Wraith experiments, returned to their native population to breed the trait into the population

Talus - original world of the ancestors

Talus – Lantean Replicator Asurian

Taranis/Taranans – planet was destroyed by a super volcano. Atlantis folks evacuated most of the population and resettled them. On that planet they found an abandoned Aurora class ship named the Hipapheralkus, which Sheppard renamed Orion. In exchange for evacuating the people, Atlantis has been allowed to 'borrow' the space ship. They were relocated to another planet, but were found by Michael who murdered them all in his genetic experiments

Tavris – Son of the Lord Protector

Teer – Avrid's sister

Teldy, Ann, Major - SGA team leader

Telnorran Generator – powering Aiden's computers

Temple of Larris – place Harmony had to go to complete her rite of passage

Tendol Feast – A traditional Athosian feast

Teyla Emmagan – Daughter of Tughan, from Ethos and now part of the Atlantis Team, can sense the Wraith because she has some Wraith DNA and is genetically part Wraith. Her people were experimented with to make them more compatible in feeding. She can sense the Wraith and even read their thoughts with effort

The Beast – protector of the Temple of Larris and the queen. In reality, they are Mini Drones, left over Ancient tech

The Cloister – a safe place where a group of people try to attain Ascension

The Keeper – the Wraith that was charged with keeping her sleeping kin safe. Now that she is dead, the others will awaken

Todd – a wraith that had been captured by the Genii. He helped Sheppard escape and then asked for their assistance again in defeating the Replicators.

10,000 years old, he witnessed the Attero device when it was first turned on

Toran – Ethosian

Toran – Genii leading the mission to kill Harmony

Torrell – leader of the prisoners on Arlesia's version of Alcatraz. Went with the rest of the prisoners to one of Atlantis' alpha sites

Torren - Teyla's father

Travelers – people that spend their whole lives on ships. It started out as a way to flee from the Wraith, but is now a way of life

Trebal, Officer – first officer on the Aurora. Her identity was assumed by a Wraith attempting to gain access to the knowledge held by the Aurora's captain.

Tria – Captain Helia's ship. It was traveling to Earth when its hyperdrive engine failed. It continued the journey but was found by the Daedalus and has been helped back to Atlantis They returned to Atlantis to reclaim their city and were all murdered by the Asurians

Troeil – on Edison's team. The only one without the Ancient gene

Tuttleroot soup – an Athosian delicacy. Teyla tries to make it but doesn't quite make it good

Tyre – a friend of Ronon. They were lost and presumed dead. Ronon befriended them and was going to join them until it was revealed that they had become Wraith Worshipers. Ara and Rakai were killed, Tyre escaped. dies taking out some wraith

Tyrus – Sora's father and Genii scientist. He was killed on board a Wraith ship and Sora blames Teyla.

Vedeena – Davos' planet

Vedeenans – the Seer's people

Vega, Alicia, Capt - SGA team member, KIA by Michael's escaped experiments

Vidina - Planet that SGA visits

Villick – Assigned to Atlantis

Vogel, Dr. – Scientist on Atlantis Likes pastries

Vonos – villager on Taranis. He didn't want to evacuate and led a group to outrun the volcano. It is presumed that he died

W

Wagner – killed by virus

Wallace – Member of Sheppard's new team after he returned to Earth. He fell and broke his ankle

Wallace, Henry – CEO of Devlin Medical Technologies. He kidnapped Jeanie Miller to force them to fix the code of the nanites to make them work to save his daughter. It failed and she died, as did he when a Wraith (Todd) fed on him

Wallace, Sharon – daughter of Henry Wallace, CEO of Devlin Medical Technologies. She was suffering from acute lymphatic leukemia. She was given nanites in hopes of a cure but they failed

Wallace, Simon Dr. – Weir's boyfriend. Broke up with her while she was gone. He met someone else. Refused to participate in the second Atlantis expedition

Watson, James, Dr. - was exploring a lab in Atlantis. He was exposed to an ancient device that led to the formation of explosive tumors. He exploded, killing Beckett and an explosives containment person.

Weir - resurrected in Fran's body, she sacrificed herself to keep the other Alterrans from getting loose

Weir, Elizabeth, Dr. – commander of the Atlantis expedition. Was in command of the SGC for a short period of time. Speaks 5 languages, diplomat, into intl. Politics. An alternate timeline version of herself was the sole survivor of the Atlantis expedition and spent 10,000 years in stasis, trying to ensure that the future expedition would survive. Returned to earth to discover that her fiancée, Dr. Simon Wallace has since 'moved on' and met someone else. In the Replicator attack, she was critically injured and was going to die until McKay reactivated nanites in her blood. They healed her and also gave her access to the Replicator mainframe and communication systems. She was last seen as a

captive on the Replicator city. It was later revealed that the original Weir may be dead, killed by Oberoth who saw her as a threat. However what could be a replicator version of her is still alive and presumed to be leading the rebel replicators

Wex – Ethosian boy Jinto's friend

Willa – One of Lucius's wives

Willoughby State Psychiatric Hospital – a hospital located near Washington D.C. where Weir dreamed that she was sent during her replicator induced visions

Woolsey, Robert – member of the IOA. He was with O'Neill when the Replicators tried to take the city and he observed Carter for her three month evaluation **father died of alzheimers. quarters - SE Pier, Level 19. had a yorkie, but his wife got custody of it in the divorce. member of Harvard Law Review, Chief Counsel of the US Corps of Engineers, Appellate Advocate at Hartshorn and Slaughter. Made a rule that all members of team must file a mission report now instead of just the commander and chief science officer**

Wraith – Ancient evil, insect hybrid race that feed from humans and nearly destroyed the Ancients. They slept in a ship for many hundreds to thousands of years. Have now taken their ship and are loose in the universe. Wraith life signs are undetectable if they are hibernating . Tried to genetically engineer humans to be a better food source. They inject their prey with an enzyme that boosts the human's system to allow them to survive being fed on. The Wraith are territorial and will fight over possession of feeding grounds. It is thought that they are an amalgam of humans and the DNA of the Iratus bug. That DNA can be suppressed, however such suppression requires daily injections and it does not totally cut out the Wraith memories and instincts. The wraith are also capable of taking life force from one being/person and giving it to another. They call it the Gift of Life and it is reserved for their most loyal followers. Queens reproduce by secreting genetic material into a pod, where it then grows into a mature Wraith. They defeated the ancients by finding/making a cloning facility. They stole 3 ZPM's to power it and simply cloned an army. **power changes hands by assassination**

Wraith Dart – fast ship capable of going through the Stargate. The Wraith use them to 'hunt' for food

Wraith Enzyme - The enzyme comes from a sac under the Wraith's right arm and it makes the user almost immune to Wraith Stunners. It also makes humans stronger, faster...but is highly addictive. It also appears to possess steroid like qualities as it also fuels paranoia

Wraith language – a derivative of the Ancient language, implying that the Wraith evolved after the Ancients did

Wraith stun weapon – Wraith cannot feed off the dead, so they possess powerful stunning weapons. They impede the neurons and paralyze without killing. Those shot can recover if they are not killed by the Wraith in the meantime

Wraith Transmitter – it sent out a low frequency broadcast that drove the humans – and even some Genii – into murdering each other

Wraith well – name for Stargate

Wraithbringer – name given to Ronon since, when he was a runner, the Wraith would track and follow him

Xiaoyi, Shen - member of the IOA

Y

Yamato – Atlantis team member

Z

Zaddik – participated in a massacre of Wraith. A Wraith ship crashed on his planet and he and the other men murdered all the survivors. Then he found a young Wraith girl and couldn't kill her. He kept her alive and raised her as his own. He also is a botanist and tried to come up with a serum that would allow the Wraith to feed on regular food instead of people. He was ultimately killed and his serum was a failure

Zarah – monk of the Abbott of Proculus

Zelenka, Radek Dr. – scientist. He's Czech and one of the few that can give Rodney a run for his money. He raises pigeons as a hobby and seems to have a bit of a crush on Sam.

Zero Point Module – power source of the Ancient technology. The ZPM room in Atlantis is located at the base of the main tower
